Game rules



- It is a question game which can be played up to 5 players.
- You need 5 different coloured game pins and a grid to mark the score, a set of BINGO markers and a deck of questions cards.
- Each player will have a designated country which is not his own.
- One player at a time rolls the dice. The number on the dice represents the points the player gets if he/she answers the question correctly.
- The players have to answer 6 random questions about the countries they represent.
- The game ends when, all 5 players answer all 6 questions. The score of each player is added and a total score is given.
- The player with the highest total score wins.
