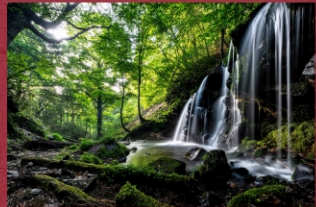
Interesting facts about Poland

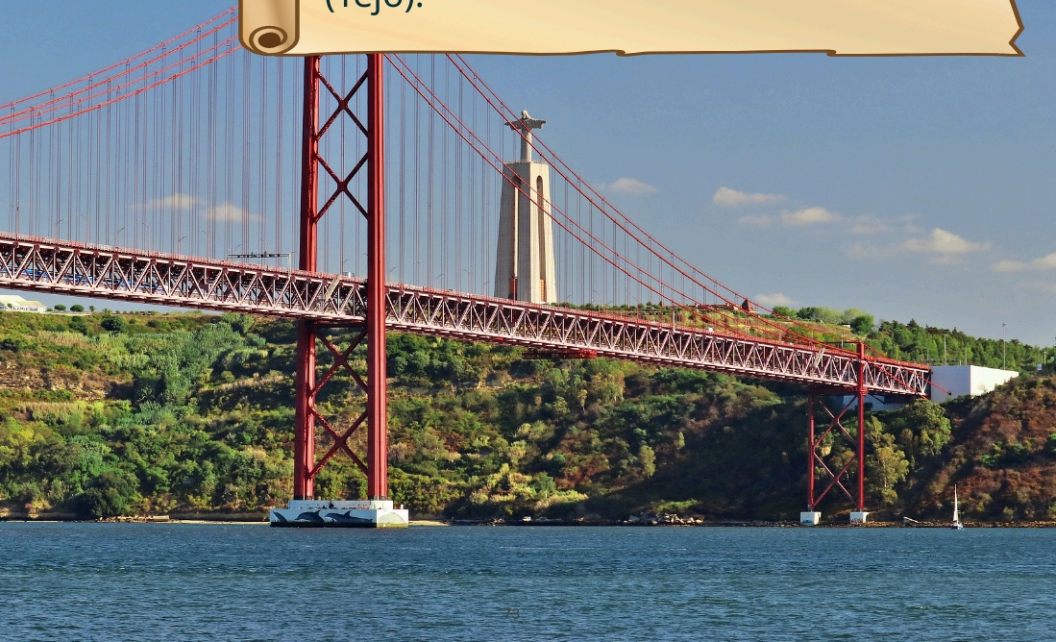

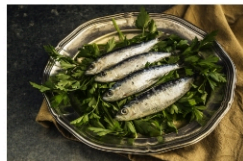
