- A bulletproof vest was designed by two Polish inventors: Kazimierz Żegleń and Jan Szczepanik
- Polish Constitution (of 1791) was the first constitution in Europe and second in the world (after the USA)
- Henryk Maguński was one of the inventors of "walkie -talkie"
- Poland is the home of the endangered European bison which is the heaviest land animal in Europe
- The Castle of the Teutonic Order in Malbork is the largest castle in the world by land area. It's also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.







Foreigners say that Polish pronunciation is very difficult. They claim that Polish sounds like a "rustle". Try to say these words:






